0142.2 - OATH

Each newly elected, re-elected, appointed or re-appointed Board member shall take an oath of office administered by a notary public or other qualified person ~~not no~~ later than thirty (30) days after ~~the~~ beginning ~~of~~ the term of office. Each Board member shall also take to which s/he was elected or appointed as well as other oaths which may be required for transactions connected with or related to the educational program of the Corporation. ~~(I.C. 33-16-4-1)~~

The oath must be signed by the Board member and the person who administers it and filed in the circuit court clerk's office of the county containing the greatest percentage of the population of the School Corporation ~~school corporation. (I.C. 20-26-4-2; I.C. 5-4-1-4)~~
