Natural Gas Transport Service and Why

- Since 1998, only large consumers of natural gas could transport
- In 2006, then-Governor Mitch Daniels implemented a Directive to all Indiana utilities to allow service to all school (and government) related properties no matter the minimums
- Gas is delivered through CenterPoint system; however, the actual gas moving through the pipes is from Constellation, not the utility
 - All other fees from the utility still apply (distribution charges, meter charges, etc.)
 - Gas cost exactly as shown on NYMEX; no added fees, qualifiers, brokers, etc.
 - No minimum usages
 - No middleman
 - The largest Pools of gas behind CenterPoint
 - The only <u>LOCAL</u> gas representative
 - Results: SAVINGS of Big Dollars
 - 98% of all area school systems utilize this service







Natural Gas 101

- Pressurized gas is pulled from a well, sent to a processing plant for purification then on to many points via various pipelines
- As natural gas travels up the massive pipeline systems, Compressor Stations along the pipeline routes keep the gas moving
- Pipelines distribute to regional areas then finally to the City Gate (aka the utility)
 - Gas is also stored and can be held for indefinite period
 - The storage field is located in an underground location consisting of limestone
- Limestone acts like a sponge which is perfect to hold excess gas
- The gas is injected into the ground and absorbed by the limestone; it remains there until it is pumped out to a nearby pipeline
 - This allows for year-round availability AND the perfect record of delivering every drop of needed gas













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Estimated Savings Analysis Comparison NYMEX price and Utility price







This analysis takes the posted monthly settlement price of NYMEX gas compared to the published price of utility gas costs

The end result: Had SGSC been transporting gas, at worst case scenario, the savings for this 2-year period would have been \$46,000

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CenterPoint Energy Indiana – South Current & Historical Natural Gas Costs

Natural gas costs are passed on to customers on a dollar-for-dollar basis. CEI South cannot profit from, nor mark up the price of, natural gas. These costs are passed on to customers through the quarterly Gas Cost Adjustment (GCA) approved by the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission and are listed on the bill as "Gas Cost Charge."

CEI South purchases gas on behalf of its customers using a portfolio approach of long-term, intermediateterm and short-term purchases, as well as utilization of its various storage fields throughout Indiana. This portfolio approach to gas purchasing is intended to mitigate the spikes that often come with the market price; it does not always guarantee the lowest price, however, given the market price can fluctuate daily with changes in supply and demand. The blended price that emerges from the portfolio approach also includes costs to transport the gas to the CEI South pipeline system in Indiana, as well as storage costs and taxes. Please note: Because billing cycles vary, the gas costs on your bill will often be the product of GCAs for two different months. i.e. If your meter is read on June 14 and reflects 30 days of service, you will be paying 14 days of the June GCA rate and 16 days of the May GCA rate.

The GCA is a periodic rate adjustment that allows natural gas utilities to account for changes in the price of natural gas they purchase on the competitive wholesale market. Natural gas utilities have been using the GCA process since the early 1980s.

Natural Gas Pricing






We purchase your gas needs directly off the New York Merchantile Exchange (NYMEX) which trades gas just like corn, soybeans, pig bellies, etc.



- There are two season to Natural Gas
- The Summer season runs April through October
- The Winter season runs November through March
- The seven Summer months are typically less expensive than the five winter months given the time of year, volatility in the market, supply and demand, etc.



Natural gas prices fluctuate depending on the time of year, overall supply, are reactive to factors to include crude oil prices, unrest in parts of the world, weather conditions (hurricanes causing drilling to be shut in), production stops, temperature, etc.



When providing quotations, we utilize terms ending in October so as to catch the most months of less expensive Summer gas which is averaged with the shorter, more expensive months of Winter.

However, we are happy to quote any term best suiting your needs whether it be per fiscal year, calendar year, etc.
