## Additional Information for the Barcelona and Madrid Trip in March 2026

The decision to travel to Barcelona and Madrid during Spring Break 2026 is because it is cheaper and the temperatures are more moderate. Spain in late June can be 100 - 110 degrees! (But, it's a dry heat. Ha!)

There is a one-day window for travel. At most, there would be one day of school we could miss during the travel window, but all efforts will be made to not miss any school.

Enrollment for the trip would begin in April 2024 if approved by the board. The reason for the early enrollment is because it will lower the monthly payments because there is more time to pay. These additional months could be the difference in a student being able to attend.

Because the London and Paris trip has not yet happened, Mr. Grigsby asked EF to provide a guarantee for a full refund in case it is the most awful experience ever. If the travelers return and feel like traveling with EF was not a valuable experience, the Barcelona and Madrid trip can be canceled. Everyone who enrolled will receive all of their money back.

There will be no organized fundraising effort as a group. Travelers will have a link Similar to a GoFundMe through EF. One hundred percent of all funds donated this way goes to the student traveler. There are also scholarship opportunities for travelers. Ideally, the monthly payments will be low enough that students and families can afford them.

Travel for this trip will depart from Evansville Regional Airport. Talking with parents in the community, teachers, and admin, it was unanimous that paying more for a local airport was worth the convenience.

Barcelona and Spain were chosen so students have the opportunity to practice the Spanish they have learned over the years.
