NOTICE TO ALL REGISTERED VOTERS OF EACH
SCHOOL CORPORATION OF GIBSON COUNTY,
INDIANA, AND TO THE GIBSON COUNTY ELECTION
BOARD OF A SPECIAL SCHOOL ELECTION.

I, A. Dale Eby, Judge of the Gibson Circuit Court being the 66th
Judicial District of the State of Indiana, pursuant to the mandates
and authority set forth in Chapter 202 of the Acts of 1959, as amended
by the Acts of 1961, Chapter 302, and as further amended Acts 1963,
Chapter 390, and Acts 1963, Chapter 380, do hereby give notice to all
registered voters registered within the proposed South Gibson School
Corporation thereof of an opportunity to approve or reject the proposal
for the formation of the South Gibson School Corporation at the Primary
Election to be held on May 5, 1964.

The South Gibson School Corporation as proposed by the Gibson
County Committee for reorganization of School Corporations provides as
follows:

1. Name - The name of the School Corporation shall be the South
Gibson School Corporation.
2. Boundaries - The South Gibson School Corporation shall consist
of the entire area of Johnson Township, Union Township,
Montgomery Township and Wabash Township and its exterior
boundaries shall be coterminous with the boundaries of the four
townships.
3. Board of School Trustees - The Board of School Trustees of the
South Gibson School Corporation shall consist of three (3)
members.

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4. The control and administration of the South Gibson School Corporation shall be vested in a Board of Trustees, elected in the general election in November, immediately preceding the expiration of the terms of the office in question, to take office at the expiration of said terms.
 5. Each member of the Board of School Trustees in the South Gibson Corporation shall be elected on a non-partisan ballot in accordance with the provisions of the Acts of 1959, chapter 202, as amended by the Acts of 1961, Chapter 302, and as further amended Acts 1963, Chapter 390, and Acts 1963, Chapter 380, summarized as follows:

The South Gibson School Corporation shall be divided into three (3) school Board Member Districts as follows:

- (a) District 1, comprised of Johnson Township.
- (b) District 2, comprised of Union Township.
- (c) District 3, comprised of Montgomery Township and Wabash Township.

Each Board Member is to be elected by the voters of his respective district.

6. The officers of the Board of School Trustees shall consist of a President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer, to be chosen from among and by the duly elected and qualified members of the Board of School Trustees of the South Gibson School Corporation.
7. The members of the first school board, designated as an interim board shall be appointed within five (5) days after the South Gibson School Corporation comes into being. In the event the appointing body fails to appoint the members of the first board of school trustees within five (5) days after the South Gibson School Corporation comes into being, such members of the board of school trustees shall be appointed by the Judge of the ^{Gibson} Circuit Court. The interim board is to serve until its successors are duly elected and qualified which will be on July 1, after their election. The interim board of the South Gibson School Corporation shall be appointed in the following manner:

District 1 by the advisory board of Johnson Township.
 District 2 by the advisory board of Union Township.
 District 3 by the advisory boards of Montgomery Township and
 Wabash Townships meeting jointly.

8. The compensation of each school board member of the South Gibson School Corporation shall be five hundred (\$500) dollars per annum.
9. A school board member of the South Gibson School Corporation shall be a free holder and resident of the school board member district from which he is elected or appointed and shall have been a resident for the four year period immediately preceding the date of filing as a candidate for school board membership.
10. The proposed community school corporations shall pay to each Civil Township, Civil City or Civil Town, located therein, which has issued school aid bonds, prior to the due date thereof, amounts sufficient to pay principal and interest on such school aid bonds.
11. Voting places - Each registered voter of each school corporation of the South Gibson School Corporation of Gibson County, Indiana shall be entitled to vote in the precinct of his registration within his school corporation as follows:

Johnson Township

No. 1--Manual Training Shop in Public School-----Haubstadt
 No. 2--Ray Schmits Farm Store-----Haubstadt

Montgomery Township

No. 1--Carnegie Public Library Building-----Owensville
 No. 2--Massey Store-----
 No. 3--IOOF Dining Hall-----Owensville
 No. 4--American Legion Home-----Owensville
 No. 5--Don Riggs Home-----

Union Township

No. 1--Public Library-----Ft. Branch
 No. 2--Fire Station-----Ft. Branch.
 No. 3--Freedom Club, Corner Vine & McCreary-----Ft. Branch
 No. 4--Freedom Club, Corner Vine & McCreary-----Ft. Branch

Wabash Township

No. 1--Upper Hills School House-----

In the event it becomes necessary that the voting places be changed in any precinct or precincts by the Board of Commissioners then the school ballot shall be voted upon at such place so designated by the Board of Commissioners.

12. The form of the ballot shall be as follows:

"Shall the South Gibson Community School Corporation, consisting of Union Township, Wabash Township, Montgomery Township, Johnson Township be formed as provided in the Reorganization Plan of the Gibson County Committee for the Reorganization of School Corporations?

13. Special Elections shall be governed by the General Election Law of the State of Indiana including the registration laws of the State of Indiana insofar as they are applicable.

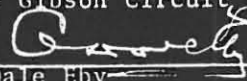
14. Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 202 of the Acts of 1959 as amended by Chapters 231, 302, 322 of the Acts of 1961 and Acts 1963 chapter 380, the Gibson County Committee for Reorganization of School Corporations informed the undersigned Judge of the Gibson Circuit Court that no petitions for the establishment of the proposed School Corporation have been presented to said Committee as of March 15, 1964.

Wherefore, It is Ordered and Directed that the notice of said school election shall be published in the Owensville Star Echo, a newspaper of general circulation, printed and published in Gibson County, Indiana, which notice shall be given not less than ten (10) days nor more than fifteen (15) days prior to the election on May 5, 1964.

It is further ordered that the copy of this order of notice of the special school election shall be spread of record on the Civil Order Book of this Court and certified copy of the same shall be forwarded to the Owensville Star Echo.
