

REORGANIZATION
OF THE BOARD OF SCHOOL TRUSTEES
SOUTH GIBSON SCHOOL CORPORATION

1. Name - The name of the School Corporation shall be the South Gibson School Corporation.
2. Boundaries - The South Gibson School Corporation shall consist of the entire area of Johnson Township, Union Township, Montgomery Township, and Wabash Township and its exterior boundaries shall be coterminous with the boundaries of the four townships.
3. Board of School Trustees - The Board of School Trustees of the South Gibson School Corporation shall consist of seven (7) members.
4. The control and administration of the South Gibson School Corporation shall be vested in a Board of Trustees, elected in the general election in November, immediately preceding the expiration of the terms of the office in question, to take office at the expiration of said terms.
5. Each member of the Board of School Trustees in the South Gibson Corporation shall be elected on a non-partisan ballot in accordance with the provisions of the Acts of 1971, P.L. 315 Section 2, as amended by the Acts of 1978, P.L. 109 Section 1, summarized as follows:

The South Gibson School Corporation shall be divided into four (4) School Board member Districts as follows:

- (a) District 1 comprised of Johnson Township with two (2) board members;
- (b) District 2 comprised of Union Township with two (2) board members;
- (c) District 3 comprised of Montgomery Township and Wabash Township with 2 board members; and
- (d) District 4 comprised of the South Gibson School Corporation with one (1) board member.

Each board member is to be elected by the voters of his respective district in the general election. Each board member is to be elected by all registered voters of the South Gibson School Corporation voting in the general election. Each board member shall be elected for a term of four (4) years and shall be qualified and take office on January 1st after their election.

6. The officers of the Board of School Trustees shall consist of a President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer, to be chosen from among and by the duly elected and qualified members of the Board of School Trustees of the South Gibson School Corporation.
7. The School Board shall consist of the three (3) members previously elected under the old plan and four (4) members appointed within five (5) days after the new plan has been adopted. The four (4) new members shall be appointed by the Judge of the Gibson Circuit Court. The appointed members are to serve until their successors and duly elected and qualified which will be on January 1st after their election.
 - (a) The members of the board elected from District 1 and District 2 in the 1976 General Election shall hold office until their successors are duly elected and qualified which will be on January 1, 1983 1985.
 - (b) The member of the board elected from District 3 in the 1978 general election shall hold office until his successor is duly elected and qualified which will be on January 1, 1985.
 - (c) The three (3) members of the board appointed for District 1, District 2, and District 4 shall hold office until their successors are duly elected and qualified which will be on January 1, 1985, 1983.
 - (d) The member of the board appointed for District 3 shall hold office until his successor is duly elected and qualified which will be on January 1, 1983.
8. The compensation of each school board member of the South Gibson School Corporation shall be One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) per annum.

9. A school board member of the South Gibson School Corporation shall be a registered voter and resident of the school board member district from which he is elected or appointed and shall have been a resident for the two (2) year period immediately preceding the date of filing as a candidate for school board membership.
10. The school corporation shall pay to each Civil Township, Civil City or Civil Town, located therein, which has issued school aid bonds, prior to the due date thereof, amounts sufficient to pay principal and interest on such school aid bonds.
11. Effective Date - This plan shall come into effect upon adoption.
